EPISTLE: ACTS 16: 16-34 **MATINS:** John 20: 11-18/LITURGY: John 9: 1-38

Troparion: "Let us, the faithful, praise and worship the Word, co-eternal with the Father and the Spirit; born for our sakes from a Virgin. For He willed to be lifted up on the Cross in the flesh, to endure death, and to raise the dead by His glorious Resurrection!"

A POWER OVER BLINDNESS

he big question in today's Gospel story is this: Who is blind? Is it the man born with **PHYSICAL** blindness or the Pharisees with their **SPIRITUAL** impairment? Let us examine what St. Ambrose of Milan had to say about this miracle:

"There is a blindness resulting from sickness which obscures the vision and is remedied by the passage of time. There is a blindness which is caused by some fluids and this, also, when the trouble is removed, is generally cured by the skill of medicine. From this you may know that when one is cured who has been blind from birth it is not a case of skill but of POWER. The Lord gave health, and He used no medicine, for the Lord Jesus healed those whom no one else had cured . . .

He spit and made clay and spread the clay over the eyes of the blind man and said to him: "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam." So he went away and washed and began to see. What is the reason for this? FOR HE WHOM JESUS TOUCHES SEES MORE.

Notice at the same time His divinity and His sanctity. As the Light, He touched and shed light; as a Priest, He fulfilled in the figure of baptism the mysteries of spiritual grace. May you realize that the things within Christ are light. One who is cleansed by the means which Christ uses truly sees."
