To insure their understanding of this message, God clearly defined the guidelines by which He expected His "chosen people" to live: He gave Moses the 10 Commandments.

Moses' encounter with the Lord is presented to us in the Book of Exodus. He remained on the cloud-shrouded Mt. Sinai for 40 days and 40 nights, as God explained these 10 great laws to him. In addition to this, God also provided Moses with a series of civil and religious statutes for the Israelites to follow. The Lord instructed His beloved servant in other areas as well. giving him specific orders on how to construct the Tabernacle where His people



would worship Him. The duties and obligations of His priests were also set forth by God at this time.

The Israelites, however, were not a patient people, nor was their faith in the Lord as strong and firm as it should have been. They grew weary of waiting for Moses to return from Mt. Sinai, and persuaded Aaron the high priest to make a golden calf for them to worship. They turned away from the one true God, Who had freed them from their bondage to Pharaoh!

When Moses finally returned to their encampment at the foot of the holy mountain, he was enraged at this terrible sight. In a fit of anger, he destroyed the stone tablets upon which God Himself had written the Commandments, and ordered the Levites to slay the unfaithful sons and daughters of Israel. We read in the Book of Exodus that some 3,000 people lost their lives that day.

In His mercy, God later re-affirmed His covenant with the Israelites. Moses returned to the top of Mt. Sinai, where he was given 2 new stone tablets containing God's special precepts as a symbol of this renewal of promise between God and His people.
