"OUR HEART IS RESTLESS UNTIL IT RESTS IN THE LORD"

s we continue to prepare for the beginning of Great Lent, our Holy Church places before us today the Parable of the PRODIGAL SON. It is a story that graphically points out the impetuousness of youth through the character of the youngest son, who impatiently demanded his inheritance and consequently lost everything. It is a tale of unconditional mercy, as the father in the parable - symbolizing God Himself - lovingly welcomes home his humbled, repentant offspring.

More importantly, however, the Parable of the Prodigal Son can be likened to each of us looking in a mirror. In effect, this is a story about ALL OF US. At one time or another, everyone of us has given in to the same temptations that clouded the thinking of the Prodigal Son. We have abandoned our Father's house and have strayed from the path that has been set for us. We have all foolishly felt that we can make it through life doing things "our way."

Inevitably, we must all realize that seeking a life of PLEASURE cannot bring us true HAPPINESS, for this can only be found when we are in communion with God. As St. Augustine tells us: "Our heart is restless until it rests in the Lord."

It is never too late to "rise and go to our Father." He waits for all of us to return to Him! He offers us something far more valuable than a robe, ring and sandals when we repent - He promises us a place in His Heavenly Kingdom.
