(Commemorating the Burning of the Relics of St. Sava On Vracar)

Today's Epistle Reading:

EPISTLE: ACTS 9: 32-42

Today's Gospel Readings:

HOLY LITURGY: John 5: 1-15

Troparion: “Christ is risen from the dead, trampling down death by Death, and upon those in the tombs, bestowing life! (“Hristos Vaskrese, smertiju smert poprav; isuschi vogrobje, zivat darovav!”)

Resurrection Troparion: “Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad! For the Lord Has shown strength with His Mighty Arm! He has destroyed death by death! He has become the first-born of the dead! He has delivered us from the depths of hell; and has granted the world, His Great Mercy!”

Kontakion (Tone 3): “By Your divine intercession, O Lord, as You raised up the paralytic of old, so raise up our souls, paralyzed by sins and thoughtless acts; so that being saved I may sing to You: Glory to Your Majesty, O Bountiful Christ!”

(Paschal Hymn to The Theotokos): “The Angel cried to the Lady full of Grace: Rejoice, Rejoice, O Pure Virgin! Again, I say Rejoice, your Son is risen from His three days in the Tomb! With Himself, He has raised all the dead, Rejoice, rejoice O ye people: “Shine, shine, shine O New Jerusalem! The Glory of the Lord, has shone on you! Exult, Now exalt! And be glad O Zion! Be radiant, O Pure Theotokos, in the Resurrection, the Resurrection of Your Son!”
