(Commemorating the Venerable Mother Pelagia of Tarsus and the Translation of the Relics of St. Lazarus and Mary Magdalene)

Today's Epistle Reading:

EPISTLE: ACTS 11: 19-26,29-30

Today's Gospel Readings:

HOLY LITURGY: John 4: 5-42

Troparion: "Christ is risen from the dead, trampling down death by Death, and upon those in the tombs, bestowing life! ("Hristos Vaskrese, smertiju smert poprav; isuschi vogrobje, zivat darovav!")"

Resurrection Troparion: "When the women disciples of the Lord, learned from the angel the joyous message of Your Resurrection; they cast away the ancestral curse, and elatedly told the Apostles: 'Death is overthrown, Christ God is risen, granting the world great mercy!'"

Kontakion (Tone 8): "The Samaritan woman came to the well in faith; she saw You, the Water of Wisdom, and drank abundantly! She inherited the Kingdom on high, and is ever glorified."

(Paschal Hymn to The Theotokos): "The Angel cried to the Lady full of Grace: Rejoice, Rejoice, O Pure Virgin! Again, I say Rejoice, your Son is risen from His three days in the Tomb! With Himself, He has raised all the dead, Rejoice, rejoice O ye people: "Shine, shine, shine O New Jerusalem! The Glory of the Lord, has shone on you! Exult, Now exalt! And be glad O Zion! Be radiant, O Pure Theotokos, in the Resurrection, the Resurrection of Your Son!"
