(Remembering the ‘Holy Apostle and Evangelist, Mark)

Today’s Epistle Reading:

EPISTLE: ACTS 6: 1-7

Today’s Gospel Readings:

MATINS: Mk. 16: 9-20/**LITURGY:** Mk. 15: 43-47, 16: 1-8

Troparion: “Christ is Risen from the dead, trampling down death by death; and upon those in the tomb, bestowing life!” (Hristos Vaskrese, smerti ju smert poprav! I suschi vogrobje zivot darova!”)

Resurrection Troparion: When Thou didst descend to death, O Life Immortal; Thou didst slay hell with the splendor of Thy Godhead! And when from the depths, Thou didst raise the dead, all the powers of heaven cried out to Thee: ‘O Giver of Life, Christ our God, Glory to Thee!’”

Troparion: The angel came to the myrrh-bearing women at the tomb and said: ‘Myrrh is sweet for the dead, but Christ has shown Himself a stranger to corruption! So proclaim: the Lord is risen, granting the world great mercy!

Instead of the Regular Hymn to the Mother of God, we sing:

*“The Angel cried to the Lady full of Grace: Rejoice, rejoice, O Pure Virgin!
Again I say rejoice! Your Son has risen from His three days in the tomb! With
Himself, He has raised all the dead! Rejoice, rejoice all you people!
Shine! Shine! Shine O New Jerusalem! The Glory of the Lord has shone on you!
Exult now and be glad, O Zion! Be radiant, O Pure Theotokos, in the Resurrection
Of Your Son!”*
