# What Sunday Can Do For Us ——

It was on the Lord's Day that St. John saw the splendid vision of God that resulted in the Book of Revelation. "I was in the Spirit on the Lord's Day, and I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet saying, 'Write what you see in a book . . . '" (Rev. 1:10-11).

It was on Sunday when the disciples, gathered together behind closed doors, encountered Christ risen from the dead. The original message of Sunday was, "We have seen the Lord!" The first meaning of Sunday was not only that something had happened to Jesus (He was raised from the dead) but more especially that something had happened to the disciples — they had seen the Lord. "Suddenly, without warning, Jesus stood before them and said, 'Peace' " (Matt. 28:9).

This remains the main purpose of the Christian Sunday. It is the day when the faithful encounter the risen Christ. This is expressed so well in the Orthodox Orthros or Matins service when the faithful come forward to kiss the Resurrected Christ on the cover of the Gospel Book after He appears and speaks to them through His word. Later He comes to dwell in them through the Eucharist.
